Abstract of the two lectures

Advance in Wound Management

Chronic wounds are now reclassified as hard to heal wounds whereby these wounds have been treated by a wound team for two to four weeks and there was no improvement. New Modalities and techniques are crucial to help manage these hard to heal wounds comprehensively. Several studies done in Kuala Lumpur Hospital will be highlighted in this lecture.

Utilization of Single-Use NPWT in Managing Chronic Complex Wounds

The aim of this study was to assess the healing of chronic wounds treated by single-use NPWT. There are five patients with chronic wounds of various size and aetiologies will be shared in this lecture.
